6. END USER ACCESS SERVICE AND CARRIER COMMON LINES

6.1 END USER ACCESS SERVICE

The Telephone Company will provide End User Access Service (End User Access) to end users who obtain local telephone exchange service from the Company under this local exchange tariff.

Customers subscribing to Company local exchange service and who access the service of interstate interexchange carriers are subject to a monthly recurring charge or the End User Common Line (EUCL) charge.

A telephone number is not provided with End User Access. Detail billing is not provided with End User Access. Directory listings are not included with End User Access. Intercept arrangements are not included with End User Access.

6.1.1 Undertaking of the Telephone Company

The Telephone Company will provide use of End User Access at rates and charges as set forth below.

The Telephone Company will be responsible for contacts and arrangements with end users for the billing of End user Access charges.

6.1.2. Payment Arrangements and Credit Allowances

6.1.2.1 Minimum Period

The minimum period for with EUCL End User Access is provided to an end user and for which charges are applicable is the same as that in the general and/or local exchange tariffs for the associated local telephone exchange service.

6.1.2.2 Cancellation of Application

End User Access is canceled when the order for the associated local telephone exchange service is canceled. No cancellation charges apply.

6.1.2.3 Changes to Orders

When changes are made to orders for the local telephone exchange service associated with End User Access, any necessary changes will be made for End User Access. No charges will apply.

6.1.2.4 Allowance for Interruptions

When there is an interruption to an EUCL. Requested End user Access credit allowances for interruptions will be provided as set forth credit allowances for interruptions of Switched Access Service in 1.3.11 preceding.

6.1.3 Rate Regulations

The End User Common Line and any applicable End User Port monthly charges may be billed to the end user of the associated local telephone exchange service.

6.2 CARRIER COMMON LINE SERVICE

6.2.1 General

The Telephone Company will provide Carrier Common Line Access Service to customers in conjunction with switched access service provided in Section 5 of this tariff.

Carrier Common Line Access provides for the use of end users' Telephone Company-provided common lines by customers for access to such end users to furnish interstate communications.

6.2.2 Charges

Carrier Common Line charges will be billed to each switched access service provided under this tariff in accordance with the regulations as set forth below. Access minutes for all switched access service subject to Carrier Common Line charges will be multiplied by the Access per minute rate as set forth below.

6.3 APPLICATION OF INTERSTATE CHARGES

- A. Interstate rates apply only to that portion of End User Access Service provided for interstate usage. Jurisdictional reporting is required as described in Section 3.11.8 of this tariff.
- B. Presubscription is a service in an end office equipped with Feature Group D whereby an end user may select and designate to the Company an IC to access, without dialing a 10XXX access code, for interLATA interstate calls. This IC is referred to as the end user's Primary Interexchange Carrier (PIC).

The nonrecurring charges for a change in Presubscription are as follows:
