TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1.0 Definitions

Carrier, Company - refers to GVN Services Inc.

Collect Call - a billing arrangement by which the originating caller may bill the charges for a call to the called party, provided the called party agrees to accept responsibility for the charges.

Commission - the Federal Communications Commission.

Completed - is a call that the Company's network has determined has been answered by a person, answering machine, fax machine, computer modem device, or other mechanical answering device.

Customer - means any person, firm, corporation or governmental division who has applied for and is granted service or who is responsible for payment of service.

Day - from 8:00 A.M. up to but not including 5:00 P.M. local time Monday through Friday.

Evening - from 5:00 P.M. up to but not including 11:00 P.M. local time Monday Through Friday.

Holiday - refers to New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day.

Measured Charge - refers to a charge assessed on a per-minute basis in calculating a portion of the charges due for a completed inter-exchange call.

Night/Weekend - the hours from 11:00 P.M. up to but not including from 8:00 A.M. Sunday through Friday, and from 8:00 A.M. Saturday up to but not including 5:00 P.M. Sunday.

Operator Dialed Surcharge - this charge applies to calls when the user dials "00" only or any valid company operator access code and requests the operator dial the destination number.

Operator Station Call - a service by which the originating customer requests the assistance of a company operator to place or bill the call. Calls billed collect to a telephone company issued Calling Card or to a third party are Operator Station Calls unless the call is placed on a person-to-person basis.

Person-to-Person Call - a service by which the person originating the call specifies to the company operator a particular person to be reached, a particular mobile station, a particular station, room number, department, or office to be reached through a PBX attendant.

Residential Customer - is a customer who has telephone service at a dwelling and the service is used primarily for domestic or social purposes. All other customers are non-residential customers.

Service - means any telecommunications service(s) provided by the carrier under these schedules.

Station - is a telephone instrument consisting of a connected transmitter, receiver, and associated apparatus to permit sending or receiving telephone messages.

Third-Party Billing - a billing arrangement by which the charges for a call may be billed to a telephone number that is different from the calling number.

Time period - means the interval of hours that distinguish rate periods. See Page 7 for a full explanation of the time periods that apply to calls.

Travel Card - is a credit or debit card issued by Carrier that allows Subscribers and/or Users to make telephone calls and charge the calls to a credit or debit account. Calls charged to a carrier-issued credit travel card will appear on the Subscriber's regular monthly bill.

User - is the person(s) utilizing Carrier's services.

2.0 General Description of Services Offered

1. These Terms and Conditions and Rate Schedules govern Carrier services Specific services and rates are described in the Rate Schedules.
2. Carrier services are available 24 hours per day, 7 days a week.
3. Carrier services are available for both residential and non-residential customers.
4. Carrier provides inter exchange telecommunication services, including switched and dedicated access long distance communications service. Calls are rated based on the duration of the call.

3.0 Calculation of Rates

1. Rates for service are based on airline mileage between rate centers of the calling and called stations. The location of Rate Centers is based on information provided by Bell Operating Companies. Mileage is calculated using the Vertical and Horizontal (V& H) coordinate system from the National Exchange Carriers Association Tariff FCC No. 4.
2. The chargeable time of a call is timed and measured by the underlying carrier. Timing of calls begins when the call is answered at the called station. Different rates may apply depending on the time of day or day of week the call is made. Calls originating in one time period and terminating in another time period will be billed according to the rates in effect during each portion of the call.
4. Billing for calls placed over Carrier's network is based in part on the duration of the call. Billing is a minimum of one (1) minute. After the initial minute, calls are billed in six second increments for the remainder of the call. Any fractional portion of a call is rounded up to the next highest billing increment.

4.0 Credit, Collection, and Dispute Resolution Procedures

1. For billing purposes, service is established on the date the customer's local exchange carrier switches the customer's service to the reselling Carrier's network.
2. Carrier bills charges monthly in arrears. For billing purposes, a month consists of thirty (30) days.
3. Carrier does not charge a fee to restore service that was disconnected for non-payment of bills, violation of the Terms and Conditions, or fraudulent use of Carrier's services.
4. All taxes are listed as separate line items and are not included in the rates quoted in the Rate Schedules.
5. Carrier charges Seven Dollars (\$7.00) (\$10.00 in Guinda/Capay) or the amount of the bank charge not to exceed Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for each check returned as uncollectible.
6. All customer bills are due and payable when presented. The bill becomes past due if not paid by the 22nd day from the metered date. Once a bill is past due, the carrier may proceed with credit and collection activities.
7. Customer complaints are handled by a full-service Customer Service Department. Customers may call 800-248-4200 from 9:00a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Pacific time, or submit a written complaint to:

If the customer is not satisfied with Carrier's response, the customer may contact the Federal Communications Commission.

8. Carrier may, from time to time, offer promotional offerings.

5. Interruption of Service/Liability

1. Carrier will attempt to provide continuous and uninterrupted service. When Carrier schedules a service interruption for maintenance or repairs, Carrier will notify customers of the cause and expected duration of the interruption at least 24 hours in advance, when possible.

2. Carrier's liability for damages arising out of mistakes, interruptions, omission, delays, errors, or defects in the transmission occurring in furnishing service or in Carrier facilities, and not caused by the negligence of its employees or agents, will not exceed the amount that Carrier would have charged the customer for service for the period the aforementioned faults occur.

3. Upon customer request, Carrier will credit a customer's account for service interruptions which are not due to Carrier's testing or adjusting, negligence of the customer, or to the failure of channels or equipment provided by the customer. Before requesting a credit, the customer will take reasonable steps to verify that the trouble could not have been prevented by the customer and is not in the customer's wiring or equipment. For purposes of computing a credit for leased facilities, a month consists of seven hundred twenty (720) hours. Carrier will credit the customer's account at the rate of 1/720th of the monthly charge for the facilities affected for each full hour of the interruption.

4. Carrier is protected against customer claims for libel, slander, or copyright infringement arising from the material, data, information, or other content transmitted using Carrier services. Carrier is protected against all other claims arising from any act or omission of the customer while using Carrier services.

RATES

5. Rate Schedules

1 Description of Services

Carrier provides inter-exchange telecommunications services, including switched and dedicated access long distance communications service, operator assisted, in-bound 800 and travel card services. Calls are rated based on the duration of the call.

Calculation of Usage Rates

Billing for calls placed over Carrier's network is based in part on the duration of the call. Billing is in one (1) minute increments. Timing begins when the called station is answered, as determined by standard industry methods generally in use for ascertaining answer, including hardware answer supervision in which the local telephone company sends a signal to the switch. A call is terminated when either party (called or calling) hangs up. Upon request of the Subscriber, credit will be provided for uncompleted calls/wrong numbers. Any fractional portion of a call is rounded up to the next highest billing increment.

3. Rate Schedules

This section sets forth the rates and charges applicable to Carrier's service offerings.

(a) Message Telecommunications Services

Message Telecommunications Services consist of the furnishing of direct-dialed message telephone service between telephone stations located within the country. The rates listed below are the maximum rates that may be applied. The minimum rates charged are 25% of the rates listed in the table below.

(b) Operator Services

The use of the carrier's Operator Services allows a customer to select from special call handling or billing arrangements. Rates vary based on call type (i.e., calling card, collect, third-party billed, station-to station or person-to person). The rates listed below are the maximum rates that may be applied. The minimum rates charged are 25% of the rates listed in the table below. A per call service charge applies in addition to usage charges.

800 Service is an inbound toll-free service that is ordered and billed to the customer receiving the call. It is provided on a switched basis. The rates listed below are the maximum rates that may be applied. The minimum rates charged are 25% of the rates listed in the table below.

(f) Long Distance Directory Assistance

Directory Assistance is available to customers. The Directory Assistance charge applies to each call to the directory assistance bureau. The charge applies regardless of whether the directory assistance bureau is able to furnish the requested number.

Long Distance directory assistance is available at \$1.99 per inquiry.

OPTIONAL TOLL CALLING PLANS

7. Optional calling plans and promotional programs are offered and readily available at rates lower than the maximum rates listed in Section 6. Some calling plans may have an additional charge that may be applied to include intrastate minutes. Call your local business office for details on whether these surcharges could affect your state. Additional promotional offers and optional calling plans are available to customers who enter into a contract for long distance service. Contact your local business office for more information.

Frontier Digital Phone Service

Frontier Digital Phone Service is a non-distance sensitive product that includes direct dial 1+ outbound service. Pre-subscription of the primary line to GVN Services is required to subscribe to Frontier Digital Phone Service. This product is only available in conjunction with the California Unlimited plan from Global Valley. This plan is available to customers with whom the carrier has a billing and collections contract. The Customer must subscribe to the Frontier Digital Phone Service local service product offered by Global Valley and must be on the main billing number on the account in order to be eligible for the Frontier Digital Phone Service option.

Rates and Charges

Frontier Digital Phone Service calls are non-distance sensitive, flat-rated with the following rating periods:

Usage Charges

With the Frontier Digital Phone Service option, unlimited usage is available only on the main billing number on the account. All calls that do not qualify for unlimited calling are billed in one-minute increments with a minimum billing of one minute per call. Only one GVN plan is to be on the account for all lines. This product is available for residential voice service only. The unlimited minutes of long distance service do not include usage for calls to 900 numbers, long distance directory assistance, or operator services.

The Frontier Digital Phone Service is offered to the residential user, for the Customer's personal, residential, non-business and non-professional use. Using the Frontier Digital Phone Service is prohibited for any commercial or governmental activities, for profit or non-profit, including but not limited to home office, business, sales, telecommuting, telemarketing, continuous autodialing, fax broadcast, fax blasting, accessing the Internet with a long distance dial-up number, resale or transfer of the Frontier Digital Phone Service or any other activity that would be inconsistent with normal residential voice applications and usage patterns, including conference calls. Average residential Customer use will be determined by Global Valley based on average minutes of use of the Plan by representative residential Customers served by Global Valley who subscribe to the Plan. If a Customer has substantially more than average residential Customer use, Global Valley may regard such use as non-residential use subject to the remedies set forth following. Global Valley may suspend, restrict or cancel the Customer's service, subject to applicable notice requirements. If it is determined that the usage on the Frontier Digital Phone Service is not consistent with residential voice applications, substantially exceeds average residential use, or is otherwise prohibited (such as long distance dial-up Internet calls), Global Valley may immediately convert the service to an Global Valley plan that charges for all long distance calls or, where systems permit, charge a 10-cent per minute rate for non-voice long distance calls, or calls that are not considered normal residential voice usage. Additional restrictions may apply.

The Intrastate Monthly Recurring Charge (MRC) for Frontier Digital Phone Service is billed in advance and can be found in Global Valley's intrastate tariff. If a new customer to Frontier Digital Phone Service enrolls mid-billing cycle, the MRC will be prorated.

Frontier Digital Phone Service (Continued)

On the invoice there will be no individual call detail for usage that is associated with the unlimited direct dialed calls that are included in this plan. If the customer changes their long distance pre-subscription on their main line without any instruction as to what to do regarding the additional phone lines, the Frontier Digital Phone Service plan option will automatically be removed from the main line and thus the customers account.

Additional phone lines are available on this plan. Each additional line will be billed a per-minute domestic rate defined in this tariff. All calls are billed in one-minute increments with a minimum billing of one minute per call. If a customer subsequently does not pre-subscribe their additional line(s) to FCA but continues to have service on the main billing number on the account provided by FCA, casual calling rates on the additional line(s) will apply.

Calling Cards and 8xx inbound products may be used in conjunction with Frontier Digital Phone Service, where available.

Usage Charges

Frontier Business Digital Phone long distance minutes are only available on your line(s) for commercial domestic outbound long distance voice usage and exclude toll free, 900, international, directory assistance, information services and dial-up internet calls. If unlimited minutes are used for non-voice calls, Frontier may charge a per minute rate listed below for non-voice long distance calls. Customers with usage inconsistent with normal commercial voice applications and usage patterns may be converted to non-Frontier Business Digital Phone service with charges for local and long distance calling.

The unlimited long distance plan may only be used for voice applications and may not be used for the transmission of data, for internet connections, or for any other non-voice applications. This service may not be used for autodialing, long distance internet or intranet access (including access to corporate LANs), telemarketing or telesales applications. Frontier Business Digital Phone service is not available with PBX trunks, ground start lines or trunks, key system lines or trunks, foreign central office services, public telephone services, and analog to digital conversion digital PBX services or the equivalents of any such services.

The Terms and Conditions may be revised periodically. Revisions are applicable to then current service and usage.

If a new customer to Frontier Business Digital Phone Bundle signs up mid-billing cycle, the MRC will be prorated. Usage not included in the Unlimited Long Distance plan will be billed in arrears. The Intrastate Monthly Recurring Charge (MRC) for Frontier Digital Phone Service is billed in advance and can be found in Global Valley's intrastate tariff.

On the invoice there will be no individual call detail for usage that is associated with the unlimited direct dial calls that are included in this plan. If the customer changes their long distance pre-subscription on their line to another carrier, the Frontier Digital Phone Bundle will automatically be removed from the line and thus the customer's account.

FRONTIER DIGITAL PHONE ESSENTIALS -

Frontier Digital Phone Essentials, a non-distance sensitive product that includes direct dial 1+ outbound service. Pre-subscription of the primary line to Frontier Communications of America, Inc. (FCA) is required to subscribe to Frontier Digital Essentials. This plan is available in conjunction with the Frontier Digital Phone Essentials plan offered by the associated LEC and must be on the main billing number on the account in order to be eligible for the Frontier Digital Phone Essentials options.

Frontier Digital Essentials calls are non-distance sensitive, flat-rated, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.

Usage Charges

With the Frontier Digital Essentials, usage is available in a 30-minute block of time. THE BOT is applied at the line level. The Monthly Recurring Charge (MRC) for the 30 minute BOT for the Frontier Digital Phone Essentials can be found in Section 4 of this tariff. Any interstate usage above the allotted 30 minutes block of time will be subject to an overage rate that can be found in the rate section of this tariff. Unused minutes can be accumulated up to a maximum of 300 minutes that will expire after 12 months. Call segments outside of the allotted BOT minutes will be rounded to the next full increment and invoiced at the overage rate.

All calls are billed in one-minute increments with a minimum billing of one minute per call. Charges will be rounded up to the next cent on a per call basis. The 30 minutes BOT includes all domestic calling with the exception of toll free, long distance directory assistance, calling cards or international termination of 1+ dialed calls. Canadian calls will not be part of the 30 minutes and will be rated separately. The monthly recurring charge is billed in advance.

International rates for this product are found in the International Product Guide of Frontier Communications of America, Inc.

Monthly Recurring Charges

The Monthly Recurring Charge (MRC) for Frontier Digital Phone Essentials is billed in advance. If a new customer to Frontier Digital Phone Essentials enrolls mid-billing cycle, the MRC will be prorated.

Customers who commit to a one year term commitment will be given a 5% credit per month on the bundle for the length of the contract. If the customer terminates the service before the end of the one year period, a termination fee of \$50 applies.

8. Promotions

Frontier Business Unlimited Promotion

New and Existing business customers who subscribe to the plan between March 1st and December 31, 2008 and commit to a one year or two year commitment will be given the following credit. One year and two year will receive a monthly credit of \$10.00 for the length of the contract

If the customer terminates the service before the end of the contract period, a termination fee of up to \$200.00 will apply.

Frontier Digital Phone Service

New and existing residential customers who subscribe to Frontier's Digital Phone Service and commit to a one year term commitment will be given a \$10.00 credit per month for the length of the contract. If the customer terminates the service before the end of the one year period, a termination fee of up to \$200.00 will apply.

Frontier Digital Phone Promotion

The Company offers the following incentive to customers who subscribe to Frontier Digital Phone from June 22, 2009 to December 31, 2009. This incentive will waive the termination fees if a customer loses their job. The following conditions apply.

Waiver of Early Termination Fee

1. Enrollment

(a) To be eligible for participation in the Program, you must be (1) employed in a capacity that qualifies you to apply for state unemployment insurance benefits as determined by the laws of your state of residence, and (2) an active customer with Frontier Digital Phone Service.

(b) If you activate Digital Phone service on or after June 22, 2009, Frontier will automatically enroll you in the Program. This offer is available for customers who activated on June 22, 2009 until December 31, 2009.

2. Making a Claim

The customer will qualify to have the ETF waived if: (1) customer becomes unemployed and are eligible to receive state unemployment insurance benefits, (2) customer has made at least three monthly payments on the specific product, (3) customer's Frontier account is current, and (4) customer makes a claim within twelve months of activating the product. To make a claim, customer must fax proof that they are eligible to receive or are receiving state unemployment insurance benefits.
